He is the former Curator of Art at the Smithsonian Institution's National Air & Space Museum and the founding Director, Fine Arts Program, NASA Headquarters, Washington, DC.

NASA worked with the National Gallery of Art presenting more paintings, drawings, and sculptures by artists that were drawn from the vast number of works produced for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's "Eyewitness to Space" art program.

The art was designed to record and to keep the American public informed of the Apollo mission to the moon through the artists' eyes in addition to films, news reports, and other graphic coverage.
