

Marvin Kalb is an award-winning journalist with 30 years of experience at CBS News and NBC News. He was the last reporter recruited by Edward R. Murrow, joining the later generation of the “Murrow Boys.” At CBS, he served as Moscow Bureau Chief, and at NBC, he was Chief Diplomatic Correspondent and host of Meet the Press.

Kalb is the founding director of the Shorenstein Center on Media, Politics and Public Policy at Harvard University and served as the Edward R. Murrow Professor of Press and Public Policy. He continues to host The Kalb Report at the National Press Club and has authored numerous books, including his latest, *A Different Russia: Kennedy and Khrushchev on a Collision Course*, which examines the Cold War tensions between John F. Kennedy and Nikita Khrushchev.
